

### **Basic concepts**


- CULTURE: beliefs, values and priorities in a community.
- CULTURE is the result of the human interaction with God's creation.
- ➤ WORLD: in a negative sense, the Bible refers to the human agents controlled by Satan and in rebelión against God.

**TENSION** 


Yuxtaposition to cultura



Christians live in tension between the divine ideal and human reality, between sin and grace.

#### **TENSION**

Christianity as culture transformer



Culture is sinful, redeemable. The problem is perverted good, not essential evilness.

#### **ASSIMILATION**



Culture is basically good, to be accepted. This assimilation tends to compromise the gospel, presenting Christ as a moral lider.
